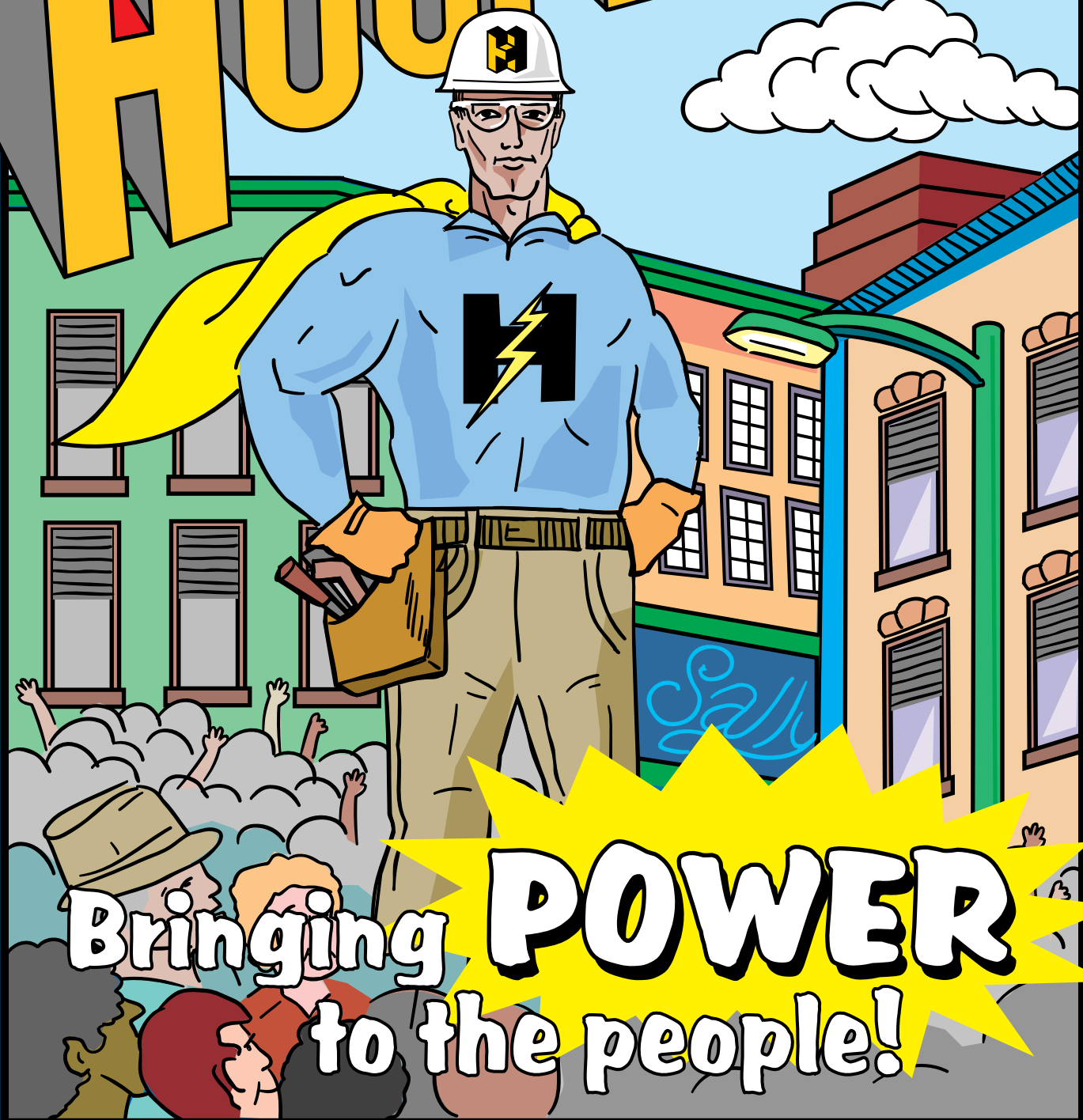


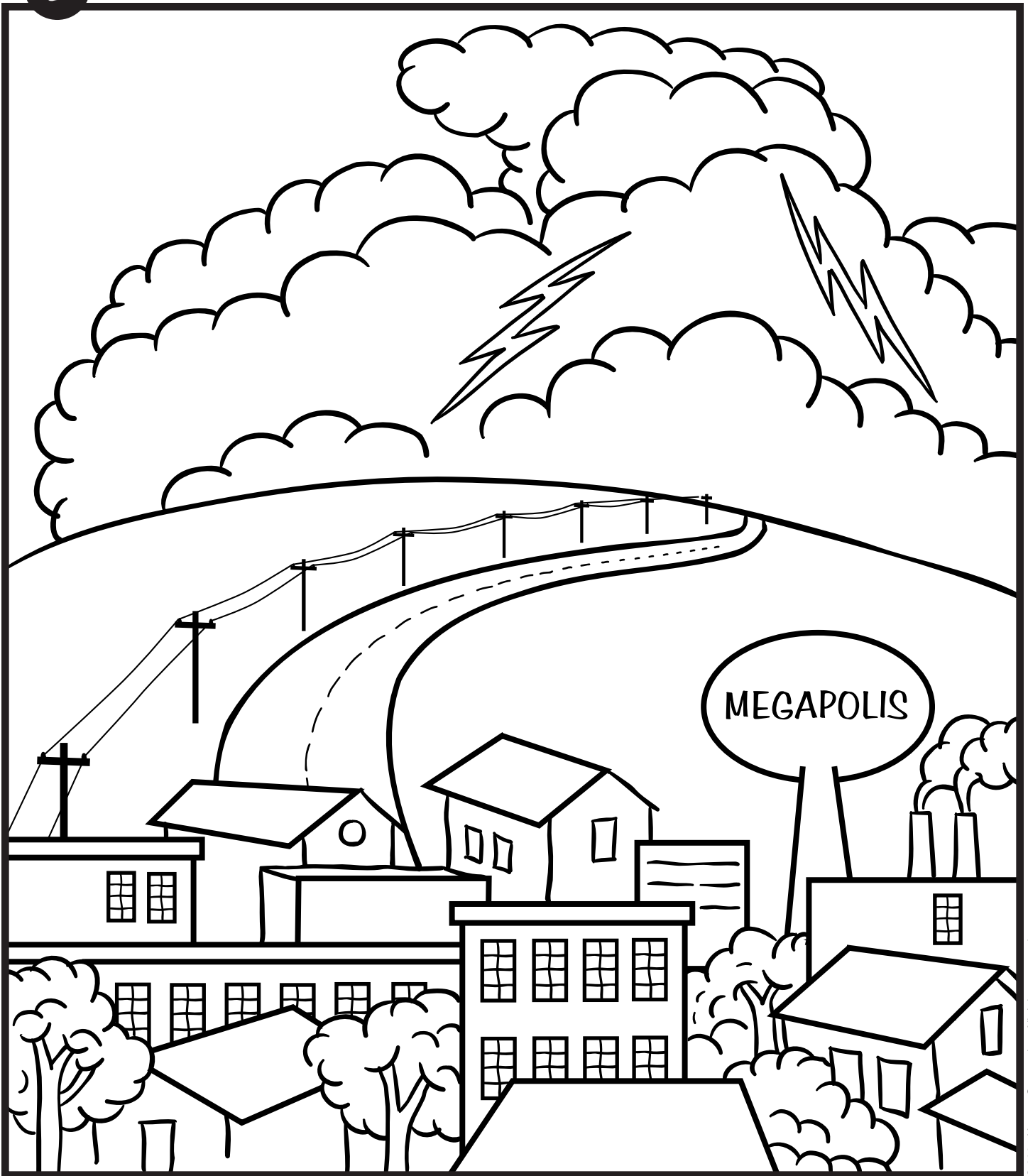

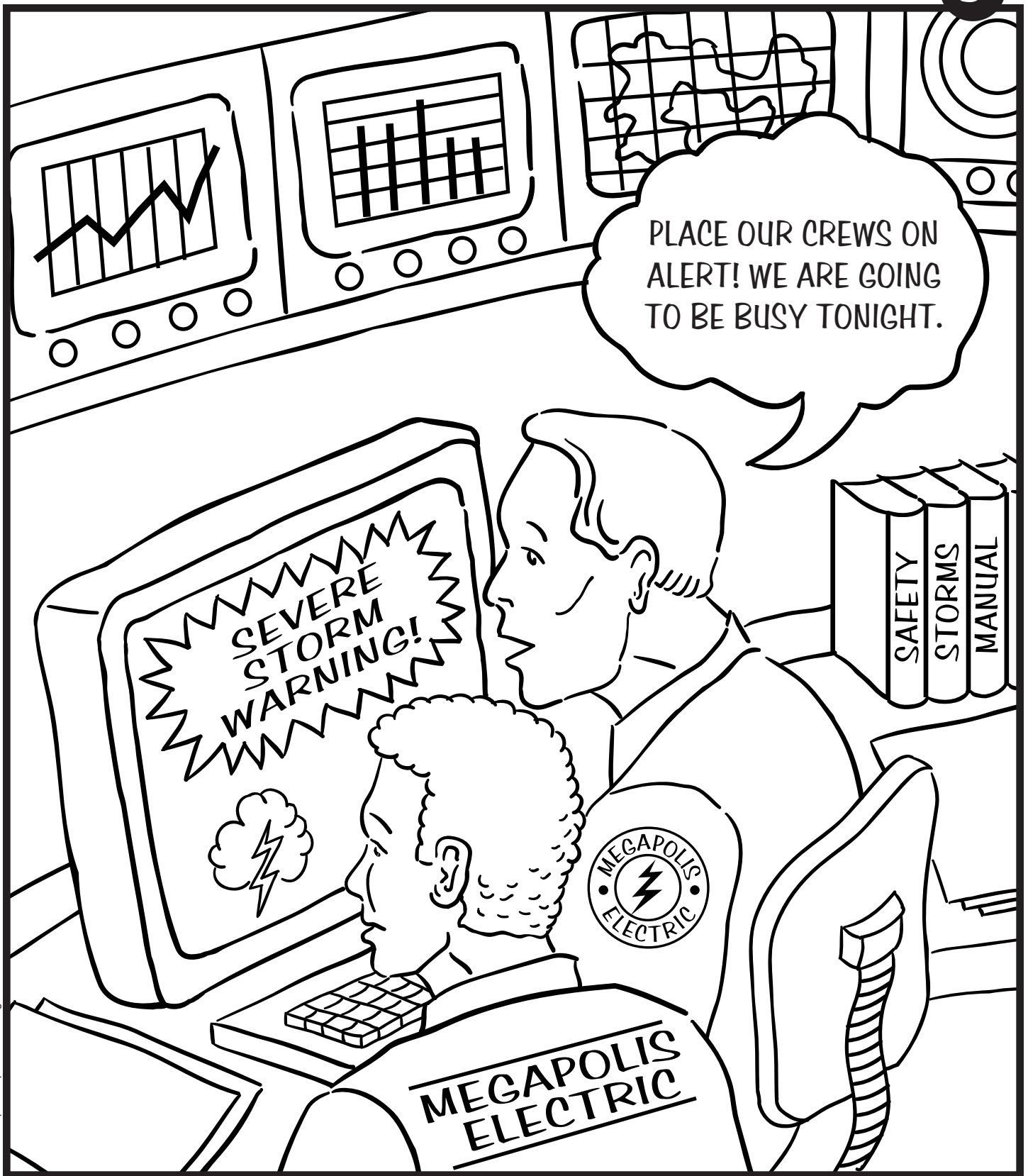

LIGHTNING SAFETY

If at all possible, get inside a house, large building, or car (not a convertible).

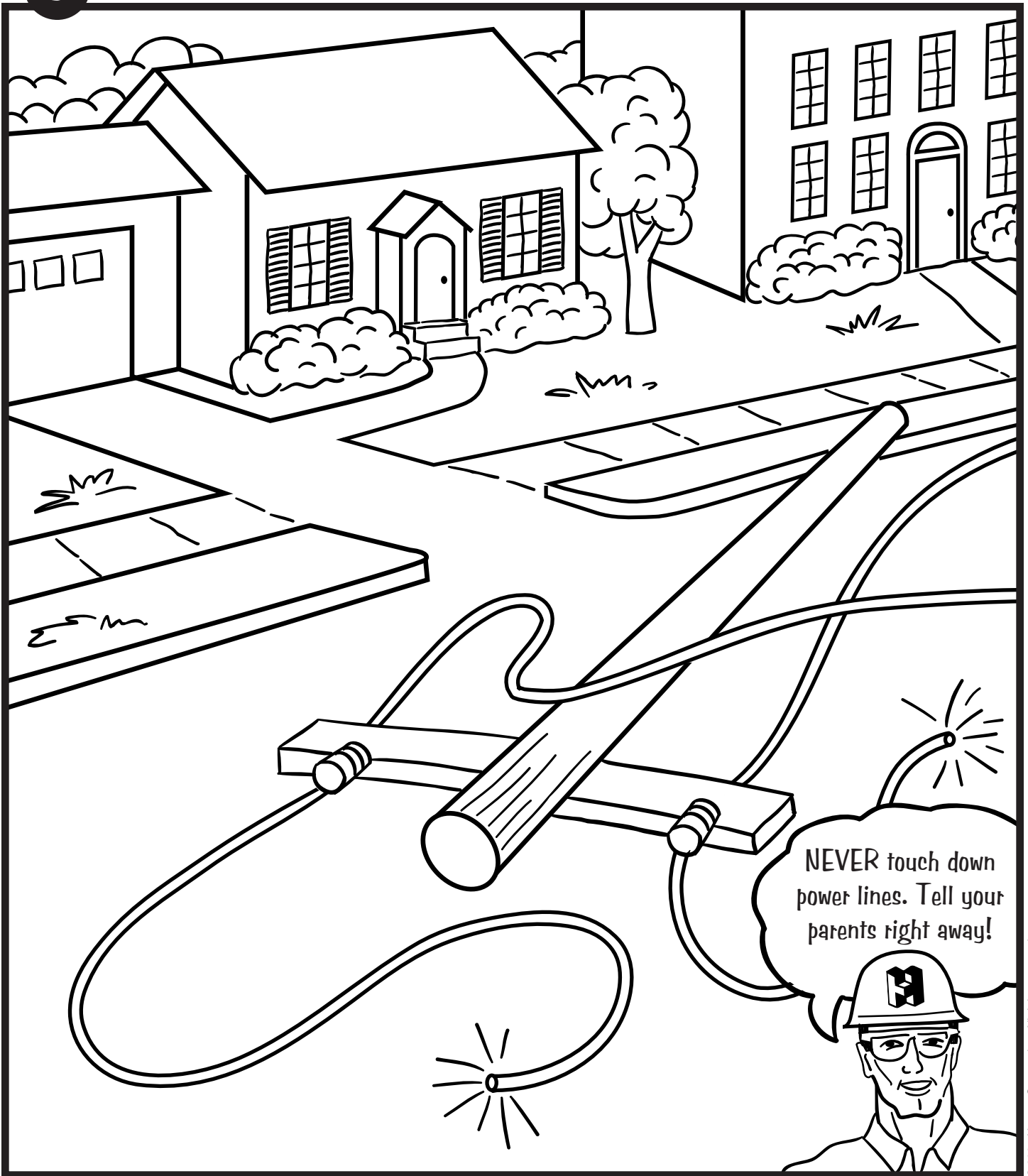
If caught outdoors:

- Do not stand underneath a tall tree or telephone pole.
- Do not stand on a hilltop.
- Get off open water.
- Seek shelter in a low place (such as a ravine, valley, or ditch).
- Stay off open, metal vehicles (such as bicycles, golf carts, or tractors).
- Do not hold metal objects (such as golf clubs or umbrellas).
- Stay away from wire fences, metal pipes, rails, and clotheslines.

SAFE PLACES TO TAKE COVER: House, hardtop car, ditch

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The cry came out for help. The people of Megapolis have lost their electricity. What are they to do?



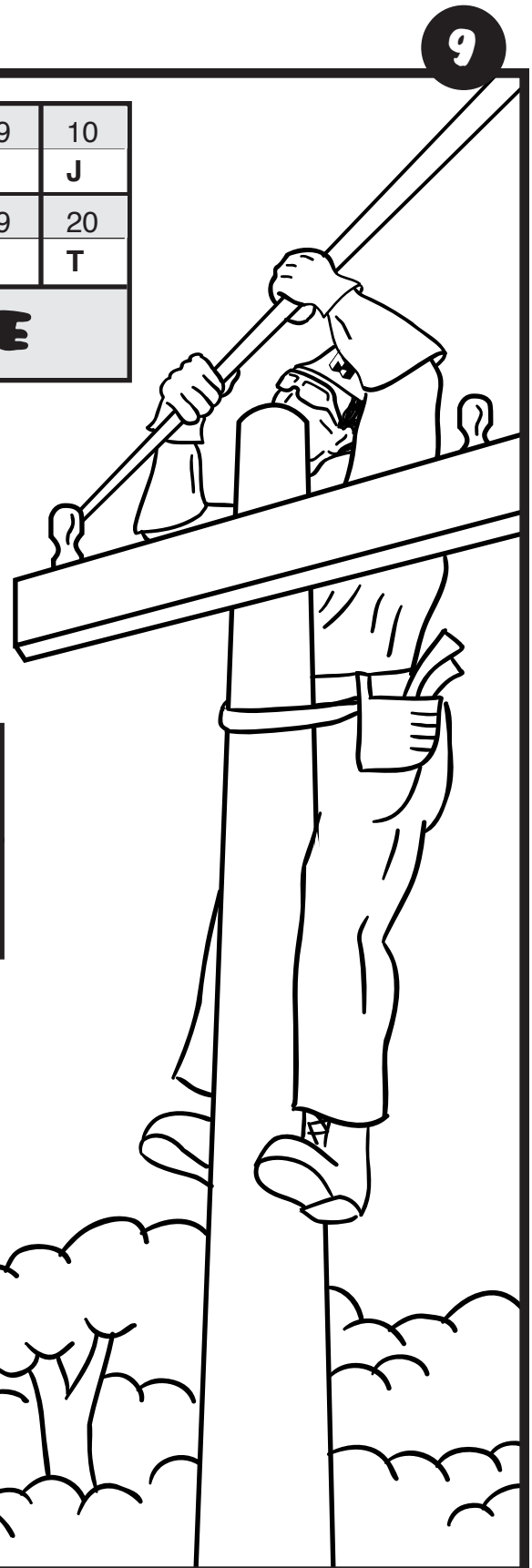
Help is on the way! Hooperman rushes to the scene. His mega-thick rubber safety gloves and sleeves protect him from shock.

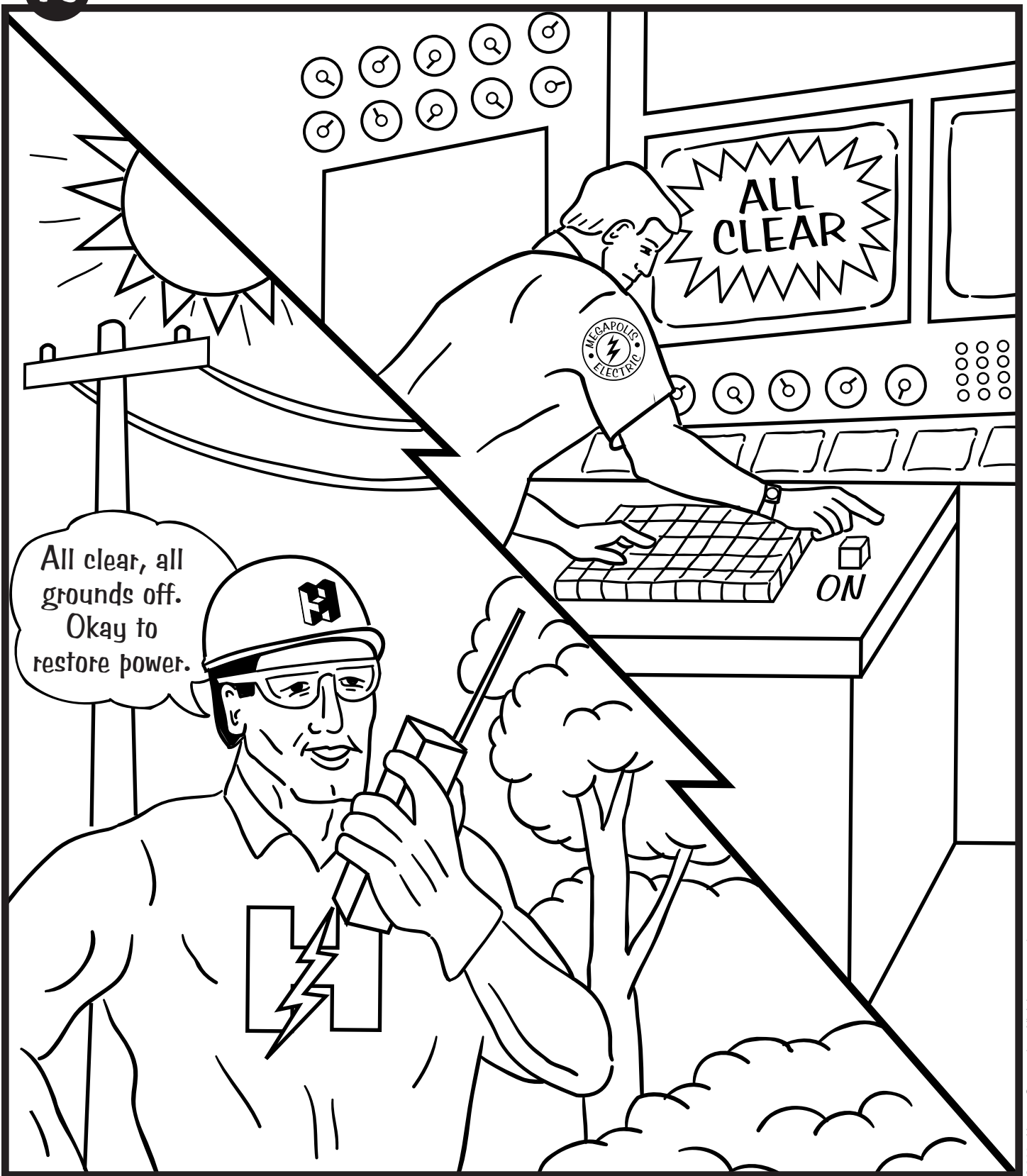

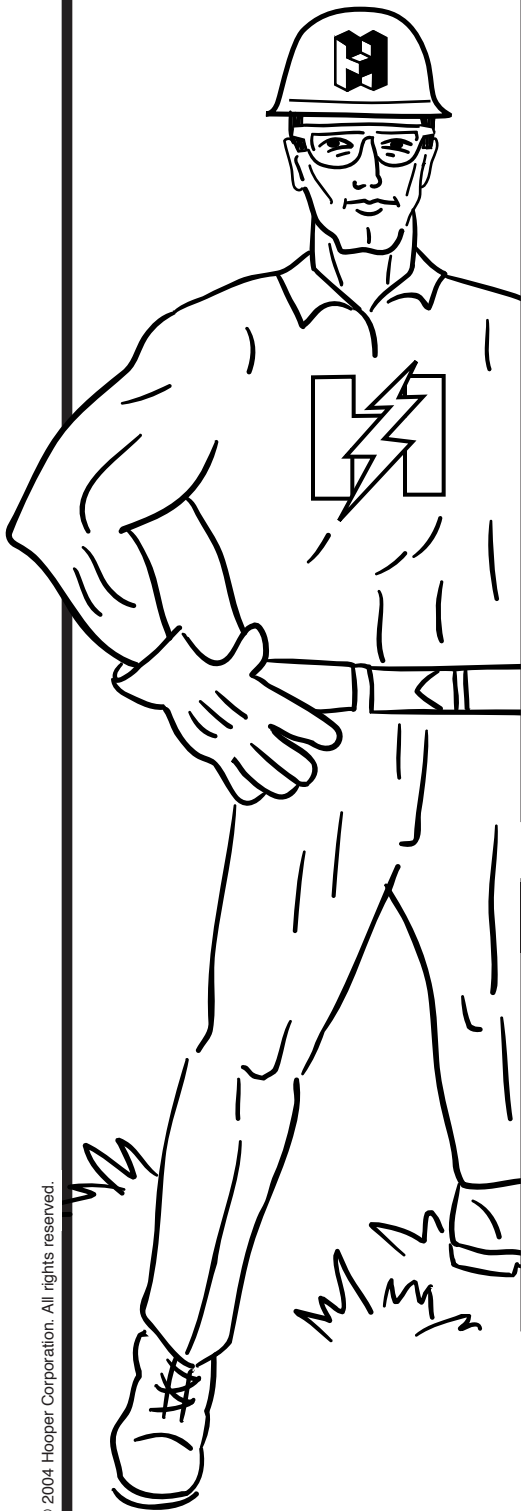
THINK SAFETY

Hooperman gets busy fixing the broken wires. He has a very important message for you. Can you decode the secret message while he works?



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All the lines are fixed. Hooperman calls Megapolis Electric to let them know it's time to turn on the power.



Don'ts

1. Don't climb electrical towers or power poles.
2. Don't fly kites near power lines.
3. Don't play near open electrical boxes.
4. Don't try to open an electrical box.
5. Don't touch any electrical wires within your reach or on the ground. Tell an adult about the wires.
6. Don't stick objects into electrical outlets.
7. Don't place electrical appliances near sinks, baths, or showers.

Do's

1. Do look above you when playing with long poles, including fishing poles.
2. Do look for electrical wires in trees before climbing.

Static Electricity Experiment

What you'll need:

Small Rubber Balloon
Water Faucet

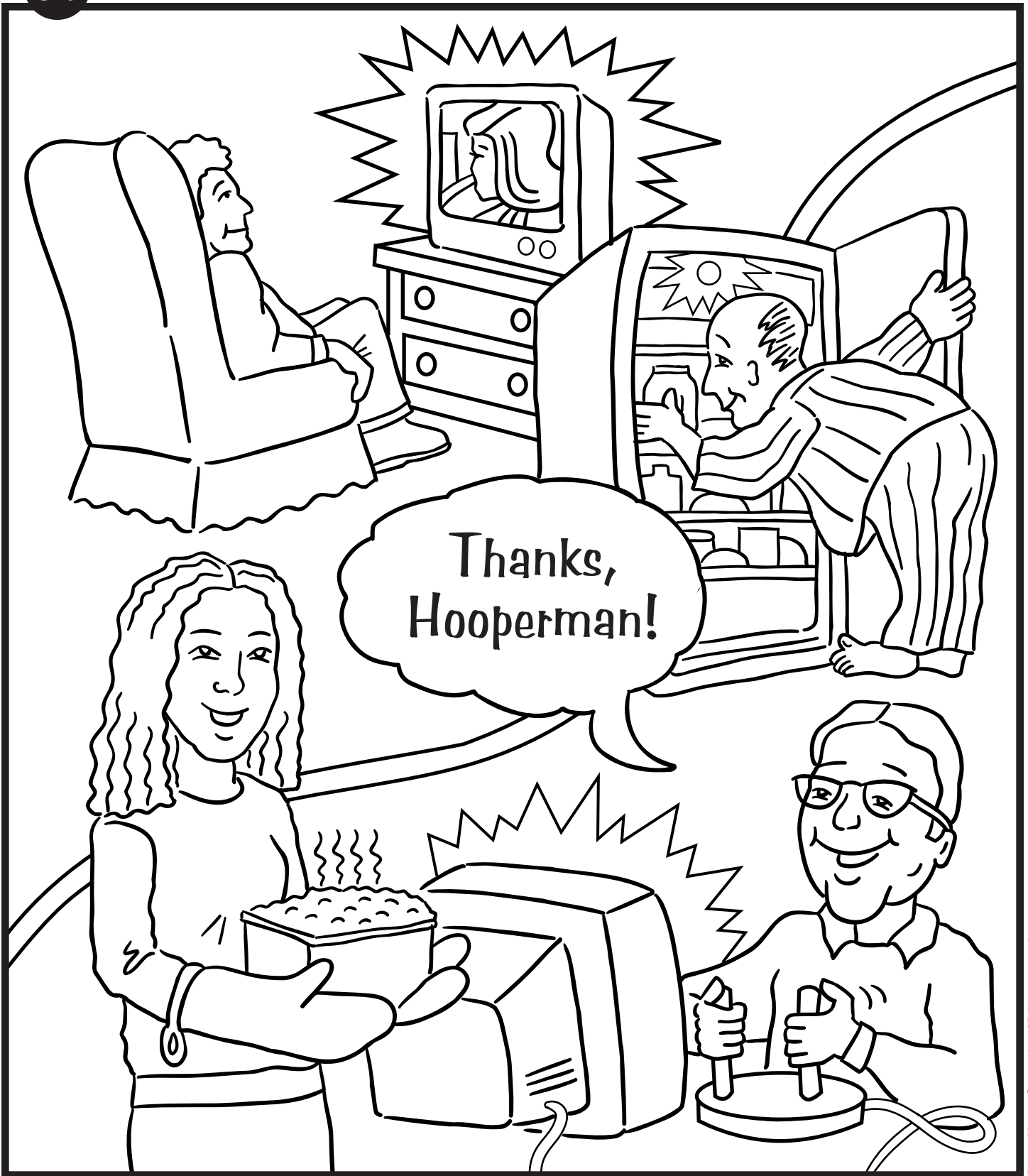


What to do:

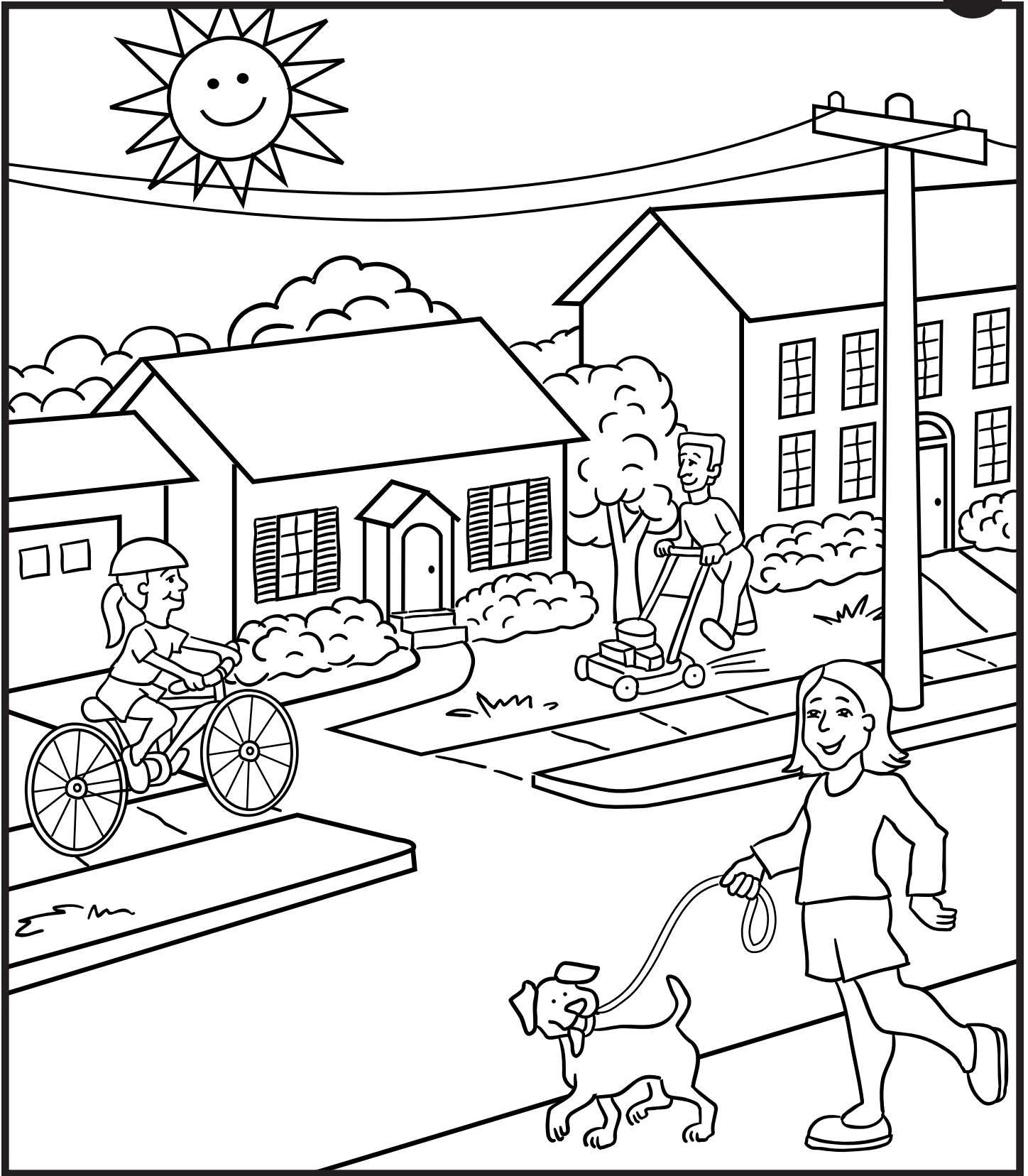
1. Blow up and tie off the balloon.
2. Turn on the faucet so that you have a thin, unbroken stream of water.
3. Rub the balloon quickly on your hair back and forth a number of times. Notice what happens as you lift the balloon away from your head. Does your hair stand up?
4. Hold the balloon close (about 1/2 inch) beside the stream of water. Make sure the balloon doesn't touch the water.

You'll see the water bend towards the balloon. This effect is caused by static electricity, created when you rubbed the balloon on your hair.

Can you make water bend with only a balloon? Here is a fun experiment you can try at home! Follow Hooperman's instructions.

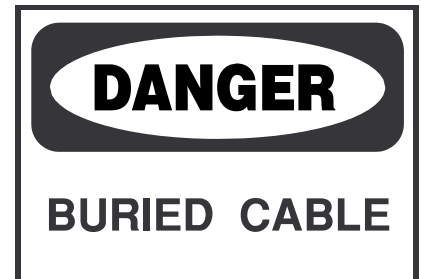
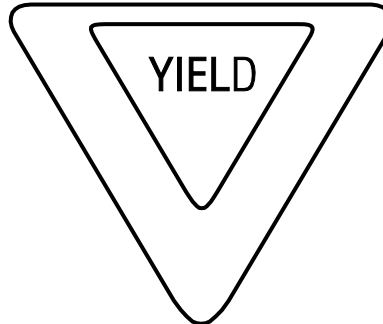

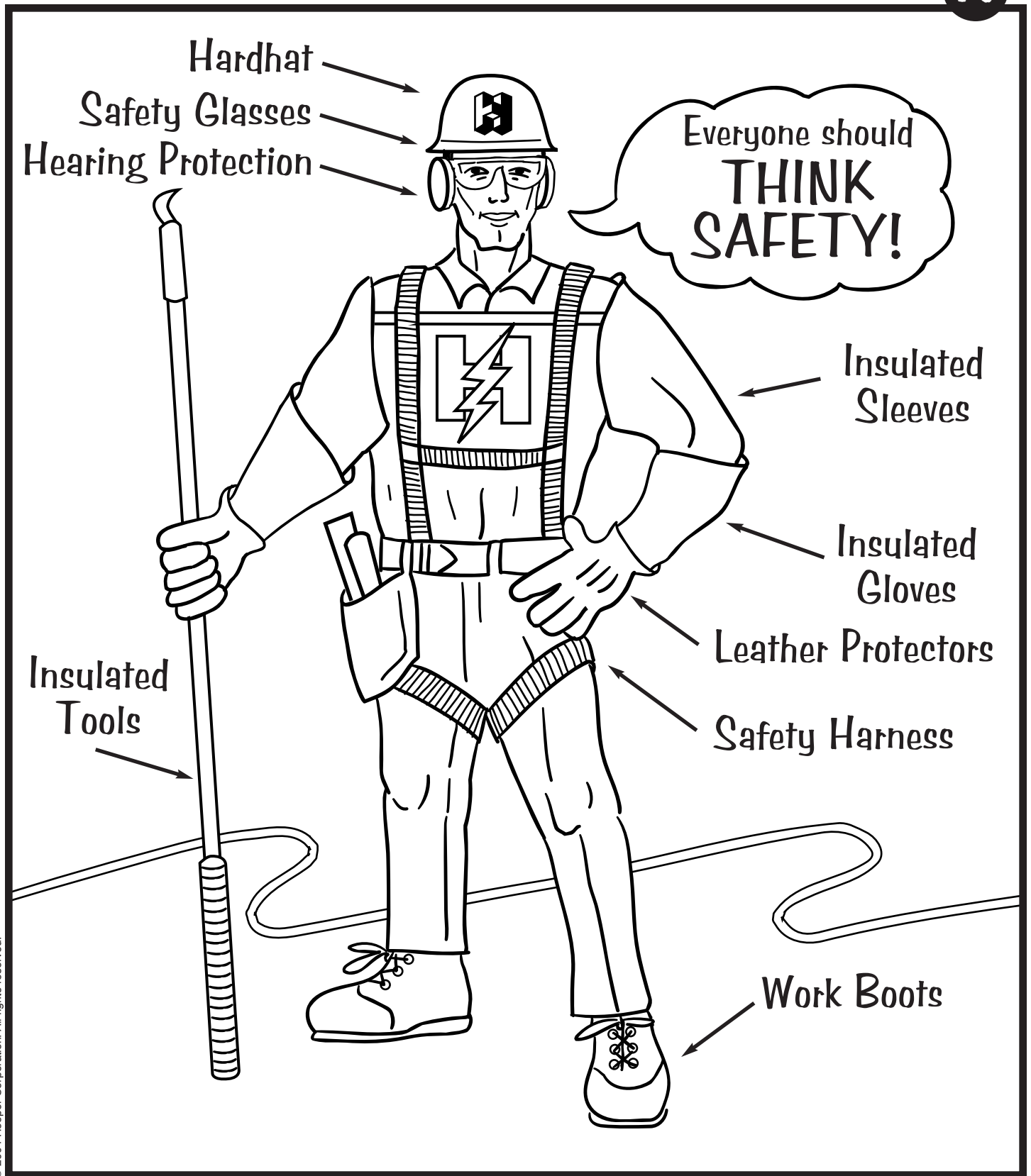
Safety is important every day. Hooperman wants you to stay safe and know what these signs mean. Ask an adult if you are unsure of any meaning.
